Colombia Internacional Open Topic

Reception of articles: June 1st – June 30th, 2024

Colombia Internacional invites the academic community to participate in an Open Topic Call for Papers.

Colombia Internacional, journal edited and published by the Department of Political Science of Universidad de los Andes (Bogotá-Colombia), announces that it will receive open topic articles from June 1st to June 30th, 2024. We invite all those interested in participating in this call to submit previously unpublished articles in Spanish, English, or Portuguese. All submitted articles should report original, previously unpublished research results contributing to the fields of Political Science and International Relations.

Manuscripts submitted for consideration must be in a Microsoft Word format and adhere to the journal's standards: a maximum length of 10,000 words (18-22 pages approximately), in 12 pt Times New Roman font, single-spaced, on letter-sized paper with 3 cm margins. The first page must include an extended abstract (including objective/context of the article, its methodology, conclusions, and its originality) of no more than 250 words. Author information should be submitted in a separate file. Footnotes and bibliographic references must follow the adaptation of the *Chicago Manual of Style* used by the journal. All articles will follow the following evaluation process: initially, the journal's committee will verify if the article meets the required basic criteria, as well as its relevance for inclusion in the publication. Subsequently, it will be subjected to peer review. The outcome will be communicated to the author within a period of less than six months from the closing of the call for submissions.

Articles submitted to *Colombia Internacional* cannot be under evaluation simultaneously in another publication.
